The Greek-owned Enfield Automotive Company built just over 100 battery powered electric cars of this type, the majority of which – including this example – were bought by the Electricity Council to evaluate electric car technology. Very compact, they were 8 inches shorter than the Mini but, because of their heavy batteries, could only reach a maximum speed of about 37 mpg. Built on the Isle of Wight, this was Britain's first production electric car.
